Women are frequently taught that if they want to be kept safe, they need to have a husband that keeps them safe. They are taught that having sex is a part of your marriage. This means that in order to be kept safe, they would have to have sex.

The dogma of marriage and sex is a major problem.

Having to have sex to be kept safe is self-contradictory, because some people, men and women, don't want to have sex. If you don't want to have sex, you don't have to. Forcing sex equals rape.
